2016 Camping Season opens this May at Rogue Recreation Campgrounds

Campers will be greeted with new online reservation availability, campground upgrades, and an expanded event calendar

Trail, OR—April 18, 2016—[Rogue Recreation Campgrounds](#), operated by Outdoors in Oregon LLC, open in May, weather permitting, with several changes and updates to enhance campers' experiences.

Located in the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest and managed by Rogue Recreation, campsites are located in various locations on Highways 62 (Crater Lake Highway), Highway 140 (Lake of the Woods Highway), and Jackson County 821 (NF-37 Butte Falls-Fish Lake Road).

The opening dates for the eight campgrounds managed by Rogue Recreation are as follows:

- May 06, 2016: Doe Point, Farewell Bend, Fish Lake and Union Creek Campgrounds
- May 13, 2016: Abbott Creek, Fourbit Ford, North Fork and Whiskey Springs Campgrounds

Noteworthy changes for 2016 are that, ultimately, 7 of the 8 campgrounds will be 65% - 70% reservable online with the remaining percentage of sites first come, first served for each of the 7 campgrounds. Reservations for Doe Point, Farewell Bend, Fish Lake, North Fork and Union Creek campgrounds can be made at [Recreation.gov](#), calling **877-444-6777** or clicking on our "[Quick Reserve Links](#)" located in the right sidebar on our website. Pending reservable are Fourbit Ford and Whiskey Springs campgrounds, which will come online early summer. [Abbott Creek](#) campground will remain 100% first come, first served.

Rogue Recreation offers a Summer Music Series and entertainment lineup from May through September. All entertainment is sponsored by Rogue Recreation and is free to campers and visitors. The venues will be hosted at the Union Creek Amphitheatre and the Fish Lake Historic Shelter. See the [Events calendar](#) on our website for dates, location, and times.

“Despite the forest fires last summer, the Rogue Recreation campgrounds were fortunate to remain open and served as a respite from the smoke and heat for many southern Oregonians,” said CEO, Alisa Acosta. “We’re crossing our fingers for a fire-free summer and gearing up for a busy season. What’s most important to us is that campers and visitors have a positive experience at our campgrounds.”

Renovations for 2016 will include new gravel paths near the restrooms at Farewell Bend campground. Fish Lake campground is getting two new flush toilets installed. Painting and staining projects are scheduled at all campgrounds. Trees will be trimmed where necessary to ease RV access. Speed bumps at Farewell Bend and Union Creek campgrounds will be painted. Miscellaneous upgrades will be implemented throughout all campgrounds as needed.

Five of the 8 campgrounds will welcome returning Camp Hosts. New Camp Hosts will be in place at Farewell Bend, Fish Lake, and Whiskey Springs campgrounds.
