### **ROGUE RECREATION CAMPGROUNDS NOT AFFECTED BY CRATER LAKE FIRES**

Campers may still enjoy a smoke-free environment as well as campfires in designated fire rings

**Trail, OR—AUGUST 10, 2016**—In response to numerous telephone calls, Rogue Recreation is issuing a statement that all Rogue Recreation and Forest Service campgrounds are open and are not affected by the fires in and near Crater Lake. The campgrounds along Hwy. 62--Farewell Bend, Union Creek, and Abbott Creek Campground--are reporting clear skies and no smoke in the campgrounds.

“The Rogue Recreation campgrounds along Hwy. 62 continue to remain open and serve as a beautiful getaway and respite from the heat for many southern Oregonians,” said CEO, Alisa Acosta. “And none of the other campgrounds along Hwys. 140 and Jackson County 821 are affected.”

Campfires are still allowed in all Rogue Recreation and Forest service managed campgrounds in designated fire rings. Under current use restrictions, fires are only allowed in forest-designated sites in the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest. [The campsite guide can be found here](#) as to those locations. Campsite fires in designated fire rings must be kept lower than the height of your knees. With forest fuels drying and high daytime temperatures, conditions are prime for human-caused fires. Exercise extreme caution when in the forest.
